

SWAN CLASS FRAMING PACKAGE

Thank you for purchasing the Swan Class Framing Package from HobbyMill! This wood package is designed to be used in conjunction with **The Fully Framed Model, HMN Swan Class Sloops 1767-1780** by David Antscherl. The framing package is supplied in 3" wide sheets of varying thickness sufficient to complete the keel, deadwood, and all of the frames. Because each builder will complete the lower decks in varying degrees of detail, this package does not include materials for planking or completing the lower decks. However, there should be ample material to compensate for the occasional "OOPS" and with some extra left over.

Upon receipt of your package, inspect its contents and please let us know if anything is missing.

In most cases all of the wood from your package has been milled from the same larger piece of material to insure consistent appearance, including your practice pieces. Typically all stock is milled slightly oversize (approx. +.005) to allow for final finishing and it is labeled according to its final dimension. For example the package labeled as .198" stock will actually measure about .203".

Included is a pack of sheets labeled "Filling Stock." This is extra material used between floor futtocks and it is not dimensioned to a specific size.

Please also find in your package a list of the various parts and their page references within TFFM. The color column references builders using a contrasting wood for the keel.
